In the interests of the safety of the whole Tour Group, I will accept the appropriate actions of the Tour Leader as final if my child needs to be reminded of the tour focus

I know that I am able to ask any questions of the school about activities I/ my child will be involved in, to gain a better understanding of the risks involved. I recognise that participation in such activities is voluntary and not mandatory. My child and I both understand that I / they may withdraw from the activity if I / they feel at risk. This must be done in consultation with the person in charge.

In the event of an accident or injury to my child/ myself, I give permission for medical attention/ treatment to be sought and I/ my family will be informed of the incident as soon as possible. A compulsory Tour Group Travel Insurance Policy will cover treatment provided by the local medical provider and a claim can be made using the Tour Group Travel Insurance Policy at the completion of the Tour. Excesses do apply.

I understand that the school does not accept responsibility for loss, stolen or damage to personal property while on Tour. A Travel Insurance claim can be made using the Tour Group Travel Insurance Policy at the completion of the Tour to reclaim personal property. It is my responsibility to check my own insurance policy if an additional claim is to be made.

If necessary local Police and the NZ Consulate will be notified of any incidents requiring official intervention.
