

SWIMMING/ SNORKELLING ABILITY 2020

It is expected that all travelling parents will be available to supervise and are prepared to swim/snorkel in the water/ sea with the students.

A ratio of 1 adult : 4 students will be observed at all times when the students are in the water.

If an adult's or student's safety is deemed at risk due to an overstatement of swimming/ snorkelling ability, unacceptable behaviour, a change in the water/sea conditions, cold or distressed, the Tour Leader may decide to withdraw the adult/student from the snorkelling/swimming area.
